Position as Project Coordinator of GLIDE in a "Midijob" for 2.5 years

The Deutscher Frisbeesport-Verband is looking for

Coordinator of the Erasmus+ project GLIDE (m/w/d) from January 1, 2026 to June 30, 2028

The DFV was officially recognized by the German Olympic Sports Confederation at the beginning of 2025 and is now working to further professionalize its structures. In this context, the DFV is also placing a major emphasis on meeting its members' needs. Since 2021 the DFV has already successfully coordinated multiple Erasmus+ projects. We have now received funding for the "GLIDE" project, a 2.5-year project focusing on improving participation in Disc Golf by underrepresented groups, including women/girls, economically disadvantaged people, older adults and people with disabilities. GLIDE is a cooperative project with ten partner organisations from Finland, Latvia, the Netherlands, Austria, Slovakia, the Czech Republic, Ukraine and Germany and stands for "Grassroots Links for Inclusion, Diversity & Engagement through Sport". It aims to empower local Disc Golf clubs to engage with disadvantaged groups, thus increasing social inclusion and expanding access to health-enhancing physical activity for all.

The following tasks arise for the project coordinator:

- > Familiarize yourself with the project under the guidance of the project author
- → Organize the cooperation among project partners
- → Communicate continuously with project members and manage regular project meetings (monthly online plus three in-person transnational meetings)
- Prepare media and coordinate the dissemination of the project on various channels
- Track work progress (esp. compliance with deadlines of various deliverables) and provide regular reports on the project status.

The project language is English. You should bring:

- → Good self-organization, enjoyment of working with people, and motivational skills
- → Interest in association development and strategic thinking. Ideally, experiences in project management
- → The desire to advance the development of German and European Disc Golf as a "Sport for All"
- → an availability to work 20 hours per week from January 2026 to June 2028.

In this position, you will be a temporary employee of the DFV for 2.5 years and will be in close contact with the DFV office. This position requires a high level of commitment and can be certified for your resume. Exciting contacts across Europe await you!
